

Directions to Brimmer & May

If traveling by T

Take the Green (Riverside, D) line to Chestnut Hill. When you get out, turn around completely, cross the tracks and walk towards the street. You will have a large fenced in parking lot on your left with a strange, modernist building in the middle with flying angles and points.

Take a left when you get to the street, walk past the strange building and you will see a second larger green building. Walk up the ramp and enter the nearest door into the Chase Building. After checking in at the reception desk, walk up the ramp to the scene shop and theatre.

If you're driving:

From downtown Boston by car

Follow Route 9 (west) through Brookline to the intersection of Route 9 and Hammond Street. (Route 9 is also called Huntington Avenue in Boston and Boylston Street in Brookline.) Turn right onto Hammond Street. (You will see two gas stations on opposite corners.) At the first stop sign, turn right again onto Middlesex Road. (You will see the Chestnut Hill Post Office on the corner.) Drive down Middlesex Road to the parking lot with the wierd building. Enter the parking lot and drive behind the gymnasium building. You will see a loading ramp leading up to the Chase building. Pull up to the loading ramp or block the red Kia Sorento parked in front of the transformer.

From the north, west, or south of Boston:

Take Route 128 to exit 20 for Route 9 east. Follow Route 9 for 3.6 miles. Turn left onto Hammond Street. (You will see two gas stations on opposite corners.) At the first stop sign, turn right again onto Middlesex Road. (You will see the Chestnut Hill Post Office on the corner.)

Drive down Middlesex Road to the parking lot with the wierd building. Enter the parking lot and drive behind the nun's hat. You will see a loading ramp leading up to the Chase building. Pull up to the loading ramp or block the red Kia Sorento parked in front of the transformer.
