

**2017 Youth Art Month STATEWIDE Exhibit BOSTON
ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Please follow these guidelines to ensure your students' works meet all exhibit requirements

TEACHER REGISTRATION: All participating teachers must register at www.massarted.com/yam.html

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: JANUARY 13, 2017

PARTICIPATION FEE: MAEA/NAEA MEMBERS: NO FEE with your MAEA/NAEA NUMBER

NON-MEMBERS: \$15 PARTICIPATION FEE PER TEACHER (not per work)

May be paid online when registering or by check when submitting work

Note: To pay by PO please contact treasurer@massarted.com

SIX WORKS PER TEACHER: ONE EACH OF SIX **DIFFERENT** LESSONS, please!

SIZE LIMITS: 2D work should be **no bigger than 24"x36"** including mat.

(Please vary the sizes! One or two large pieces per teacher is a good rule of thumb)

3D work should **not exceed 25 lbs.** (Pedestals and cases are available for 3D projects)

PREPARING WORK FOR EXHIBIT: * Please follow the Matting and Mounting direction form!**

STUDENT EXHIBIT FORM: Each work must have a completed, signed student exhibit form securely taped to the back/bottom!

ACCEPTANCE OF WORK: Artwork should be original, and no group projects are accepted.

When asking for parent signatures, please say you are submitting the work for acceptance. While this is not a juried show, the Transportation Building is a public, government building. The YAM committee therefore reserves the right to reject work that is inappropriate for such a venue. You will be notified ONLY if a work is **not** accepted!

Artwork is hung by medium. It is important to inform the parents which medium their child's work is so they will know it.

TEACHER INVENTORY FORM: A completed inventory form MUST accompany your artwork

PACKING ARTWORK ** Please follow the form, Guidelines for Packing Art to be Transported**

GETTING WORK TO BOSTON:

- **REGIONAL DROP-OFF SITES:** We will have sites across the state, (including Boston) so there will be one reasonably near you! A list of the drop-off sites will be posted on the website soon.
WHY NOT **VOLUNTEER** to be a drop-off site or be part of a **relay (or network)** of drop-offs?
 - Work is brought to site A, teacher from site A delivers the work to site B, etc.
 - YAM committee member picks up work from final site and brings it to Boston.
