ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Please follow these guidelines to submit student work

TEACHER REGISTRATION: All participating teachers must register at www.massarted.com

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: DECEMBER 14, 2018

PARTICIPATION FEE: MAEA/NAEA MEMBERS: NO FEE with your MAEA/NAEA NUMBER

NON-MEMBERS: \$15 PARTICIPATION FEE *PER* TEACHER

Pay online when registering or by check when delivering work. Contact treasurer@massarted.com for PO's

SIX WORKS PER TEACHER: SIX **DIFFERENT** LESSONS, by SIX **DIFFERENT** STUDENTS is preferable!

SIZE LIMITS: 2D work should be **no bigger than 24" x 36"** including mat.

3D work should **not exceed 25 lbs.** (*Pedestals and cases are available for 3D projects*)

PREPARING WORK FOR YAM: All the information you need can be found on these forms

Matting and/or Mounting, **New 2019 Nametag Directions**, and Packing and Labeling packages

STUDENT EXHIBIT FORM: **NEW 2019!** You must submit **2 copies** of the completed and signed student exhibit forms (*we suggest you make a third copy for your records*)

Securely attach one copy to the back (or bottom) of the artwork. Place a second copy inside your package

TEACHER INVENTORY FORM: **NEW for 2019!** Fill out **2 or more copies** of the teacher inventory form

Tape one on the outside of each package you send

Place one inside the package you've labeled #1 along with the student exhibit forms

ACCEPTANCE OF WORK: Artwork should be original **Group work may not exceed size limitations**

This is a government building and work that is inappropriate for such a venue, including nudity and violence or political work may not be displayed. You will be notified **ONLY** if a work is **not** accepted! When asking for parent signatures, you therefore may wish to explain you are submitting the work for acceptance

Work is hung by category. The list of categories with definitions is available on the website.

PLEASE inform the parents of the category of their child's work so they can find it!

GETTING WORK TO BOSTON:

- **Bringing work to a Drop off Site between Jan 9-18 (scheduled by site)**

A list of the drop-off sites across the state will be posted on the web soon!

Why not volunteer to be a drop off site or try developing a **Relay** of drop-offs with neighboring towns.
