



MASSACHUSETTS AMAZING EMERGING ARTISTS 2019 RECOGNITIONS EXHIBIT DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING ACCEPTED ARTWORK

PREPARING 2D WORK:

SIZE: 2D Work may not be larger than 24" x 36" INCLUDING Matting / Mounting.

Mat/ mount border MAY NOT EXCEED 3" on any side.

CANVASES: DO NOT mat or mount stretched canvas or canvas boards.

Prepare stretched canvases with EYE HOOKS in top 1/4" of canvas.

We will attach the wire.

Canvas boards need no special preparation.

MATTING / MOUNTING: ALL 2D work (except canvases / canvas boards)

Mat/ mount border MAY NOT EXCEED 3" on any side

WHITE or BLACK MATTING or MOUNTING ONLY

Matting: please use traditional sturdy matting with a sandwich mat or with sturdy backing.

Mounting: when mounting work, a 1/4" foam core board is recommended.

. PLEASE NOTE:

- Mat/mount must be **securely** attached to artwork
- Work that falls apart may need to be removed from the exhibit.
- No work matted or mounted on construction paper will be accepted.
- No frames, no glass, no staples, no excessively heavy matting, mounting, or backing

PREPARING 3D ARTWORK:

SIZE: 3D Work – weight limit 25 lbs., height limit 36"

Work must be sturdy; any attached parts must be strongly secured.

IDENTIFYING ACCEPTED 2D and 3D ARTWORK:

- Please print directly on the back of the work or on the bottom of 3D work:
 Student's Name, School, and Teacher Name
- For 2D work An arrow indicating the top
- Securely attach a completed and signed STUDENT RELEASE form to the back of 2D work or on the bottom of 3D work. (We suggest you also make a copy for your own files.)

NAME TAGS for ACCEPTED ARTWORK:

- We will create and attach the name tags.
- DO NOT put name tags on the front of the work.
