ABOUT ART ALL-STATE 2019: TAPE ART EDITION

AAS 2019 is a one-day program for high school juniors who will work collaboratively to create installations using tape. Each group of students will have a artist-teacher to help facilitate the collaborative process and everyone will work with the world renowned artists of the Tape Art Crew.

Students are expected to attend the one full day. Once accepted, AAS will email a confirmation that we have received all required documents. A detailed schedule will be sent at that time.

Students must be nominated by an art teacher. Teachers will fill out the nomination form and assist students with the necessary steps to complete the application process.

Step Four: Sign and return consent forms

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COMPLETING THE APPLICATION

Please gather the necessary information and enter into the application portal

Part 1: General Information: Name, preferred name, preferred pronouns, contact information for students, parents, nominating teacher, student birthday, t-shirt size

Part 2: Date and location selection (see options on page 1)

Part 3: Health / Medical Information: Medical insurance company, policy number, medical conditions, allergies, dietary concerns, accommodations or issues we should be aware of.

Part 4: About You: Leadership style, three adjectives to describe you, favorite color, favorite song

Part 5: Artwork: prompts include: What inspires you to make art? What artists inspire you? Responses should be detailed and concise (no more than 100 words per prompt), please use complete sentences and appropriate grammar.

Self-Portrait specifications: Submit one *original* self-portrait via the online application in JPEG or PDF format. The self-portrait can be any medium, any size, any conceptualization. The self-portrait does not need to resemble your physical likeness, conceptual works or symbolic representations as well as traditional portraits are permitted. Take care in editing your images- we assume anything included in the frame is intended as part of the piece. Remove distracting elements, and be sure the image is the correct orientation before uploading. Works should be original in content and execution, and abide by copyright laws as applicable. Copied works, works from photographs under copyright restrictions, or not taken by the student artist are not permitted. You will be asked to include a title, and description of how the self-portrait describes who you are and how it represents you.

Part 6: Payment Information

The cost for Art All-State 2019: Tape Art Edition is \$125. The cost includes all necessary materials/ resources, lunch, snacks and a t-shirt. You do not need to bring any additional funds to AAS.

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Part 7: Consent. Students will be asked to indicate their willingness to work collaboratively, commit to attending the full amount of time (one full day), and limit distractions to participate fully in the experience.

TRAVEL INFO: Specific daily schedule, and directions will be emailed to you upon acceptance. We strongly suggest parents drive their students to the locations. Since this is a one-day event, students will be allowed to drive their own vehicles. To ensure students are accounted for throughout the day, those who drive their own vehicles will be asked to turn over their car keys to be returned to them at the end of the day. This is for the safety of all participants. If transportation is an issue, please email us and we will assist in helping to find a carpool with another participant coming from your area.

*Parents and public will are encouraged to attend the public viewing and artist talk by the Tape Art Crew at the conclusion of the day. Please invite your friends and family. Exact times will be emailed upon acceptance.
