Call for Submission of Artwork

National Art Honor Society and National Junior Art Honor Society Exhibition

MAEA is continuing the series of art education exhibitions in the second floor atrium and gallery space at the State Transportation Building in Boston. Massachusetts art educators that act as National Art Honor Society or National Junior Art Honor Society chapter sponsors are invited to submit their NAHS/NJAHS student work for this annual exhibit.

Exhibition Dates and Location:

Monday, April 8 – Thursday, May 16, 2019

9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday - Friday (Closed Holidays & Weekends)

2nd Floor Atrium Gallery, Massachusetts State Transportation Building, Boston

Closing Reception: 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 16, 2019

Submission Deadline: *Extended* Friday, March 29, 2019

- We will accept electronic registration only. Complete the online registration form, including the proper label information for all the pieces you will be submitting.
- Participants must be part of a registered NAHS/NJAHS chapter.
- Please limit submissions to one work per student. Students must be active members of the NAHS chapter, but there is no limit on the total number of participants from each chapter.

Additional Guidelines and Information

We cannot accept submissions of artwork that exceeds three feet in any one direction when matted or mounted and or work that exceeds 30 lbs. in weight.

2D work should be mounted or matted - no frames, no glass. Please make sure there is a backing to matted work to protect it from tearing. Canvas pieces do not have to be mounted or matted. Work should not include any wires or hooks, as the exhibition committee will prepare the work for hanging.

3-Dimensional work is accepted. Small work measuring under 18" in any dimension will be displayed on a covered pedestal. Larger sculpture will be placed behind a rope barrier. 3D work should be delivered with display instructions if necessary. Please make sure students name and school are written on the back of each piece. Include all signed artwork release forms, attached to the back of each piece as well. The MAEA maintains the right to not exhibit work which is inappropriate for the venue or not consistent with the originally submitted digital image.

Delivery of Artwork: Saturday, March 30 through Saturday, April 6.

- Specific dates and times for regional drop-off locations will be emailed to chapter sponsors after registration.
- Artwork can also be mailed to the State Transportation Building at MAEA, Suite 2180 - C/O DCAMM, 10 Park Plaza - State Transportation Building, Boston, MA 02116. **All mailed work must arrive no later than Thursday, April 4.** Mailed work **must include return postage** or be picked up in person.
- The required exhibit release form must be attached to the back of each work.

Packing Guidelines:

- A sheet of newsprint paper over the front protects most work.
- If you can pack the work in a portfolio, that is easiest, but if not, it would be best to stack like-sized pieces between two pieces of corrugated board, and tape the boards, or wrap in paper, and then tape.
- Works on canvas should be individually wrapped. Don't forget to protect corners.
- Attach the Packing List form on the outside of your package.
