150 years ago on May 16, 1870, Massachusetts passed [*An Act relating to free instruction in drawing, which has become known as the 1870 Drawing Act*](#). This declared drawing instruction a vital part of public school education. Today, the MAEA would like to celebrate the progress art education has made over those 150 years. We invite all teachers to submit up to 6 student drawings and 1 personal drawing for the show. All students are welcome from early childhood through college.

What classifies as drawing?

We will accept all artwork made with “dry” drawing materials. These include pencil, crayon, pastel, colored pencil, marker, sharpie, pen and ink, scratch paper, digital drawing, and others. We will **not** be accepting any work that includes the use of paint. *If you have any questions about this, please email exhibitions@massarted.com.*

- We will accept electronic registration only.
- Complete the online registration form, including the proper label information for all the pieces you will be submitting. forms.gle/6yrbHzZHLXhL7fJq5
- There is no submission fee for this show, all are welcome.

Additional Submission Requirements

- We cannot accept artwork that is NOT matted or mounted, or exceeds 24”X36” (matted or mounted).

- Work should NOT include any wires or hooks, as the exhibition committee will prepare the work for hanging.
- Work should be backed with a piece of mat board or cardboard so it is rigid enough for hanging.
- The required [student exhibit release form](#) must be attached to the back of each work.
- The required [packing list document](#) must be included with each package.
- Please note while this is not a juried exhibit, the Massachusetts Art Education Association and the management of the State Transportation Building reserve the right and ability to not exhibit work which is inconsistent with the public venue. If you are unsure about a piece, please email a photo of the work to exhibitions@massarted.com prior to submitting.
