

## 2022 MAEA RECOGNITIONS JURIED VIRTUAL ART EXHIBIT GUIDELINES

Piloted in 2018, the Massachusetts Amazing Emerging Artist Recognitions Exhibit is a juried show for grade 9 -12 students of Massachusetts Art Education Association (MAEA) members. This exhibition has been very successful with participation growing annually. Student entries are submitted digitally and judged (blind process) by a panel of art educators.

The 2022 **MAEA RECOGNITIONS** exhibit will be virtual, posted on the MAEA website. We see this as a real-life opportunity for students to express what is important to them in a visually powerful way. Presenting the exhibit online opens up the possibility of reaching a larger audience on a digital platform.

## **RECOGNITIONS SUBMISSIONS FOR 2022:**

- 1. Eligibility for submission: Artwork that has not previously been submitted to MAEA Recognitions
- 2. Artwork accompanied by an artist statement, submitted digitally via ArtCall; Deadline: January 18, 2022.
- **3. Jurying process January 19 31, 2022**
- 4. Notifications of acceptance by February 9, 2022
- 5. Online exhibit posted to MAEA website by March 7, 2022
- 6. Artist statements will be posted along with the accepted artwork.

All artwork must be original, created by the student. It must not infringe upon the intellectual property rights of any other individual or entity. The Massachusetts Art Education Association maintains the right to determine which works of art are appropriate for this exhibit. Any subject matter that is highly controversial, items, symbols, or themes that may represent racism, prejudice, profanity, or are of a violent or lewd nature are not appropriate for this exhibit.
