

## 2022 MAEA RECOGNITIONS JURIED VIRTUAL ART EXHIBIT ARTWORK SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

OPEN to GRADES 9-12 STUDENTS of MAEA MEMBERS ONLY
Submissions Open: December 6, 2021,12 a.m. through January 18, 2022, 12 p.m.

## Criteria for Submissions by Art Teacher:

- \* Up to 5 (Grade 9-12) student entries per teacher.
- \* Only 1 entry per student. (*Individual student work only*; *collaborative pieces will not be accepted*.)
- \* Artwork that has not been submitted previously to MAEA Recognitions.
- \* No size limits to actual artwork.
  - Teachers should register with their email and submit their student work at maearecognitions2022.artcall.org
  - Student works should be photographed and saved as jpegs.
    - o Submit 1 photo for 2D work and up to 2 photos for 3D work.
    - o Minimum image 540 pixels. Maximum 1920 pixels.
    - o Submit 2D size: height x width. Submit 3D size: height x width x depth.
  - Teachers must submit student's artwork with its accompanying artist statement.
    - o Artist Statement: 400 characters maximum.

All artwork must be original, created by the student. It must not infringe upon the intellectual property rights of any other individual or entity. The Massachusetts Art Education Association maintains the right to determine which works of art are appropriate for this exhibit. Any subject matter that is highly controversial, items, symbols, or themes that may represent racism, prejudice, profanity, or are of a violent or lewd nature are not appropriate for this exhibit.

## PARTICIPATION FEE: \$5.00 Fee per entry

Teachers can submit a financial hardship fee waiver to <a href="mailto:student\_recognition@massarted.com">student\_recognition@massarted.com</a> if the fee is a financial hardship for the student.

## **NOTIFICATIONS OF ACCEPTANCE:**

This is a **BLIND JURIED** show. Notifications of acceptance will be sent by **February 9, 2022.** A **STUDENT RELEASE FORM** for accepted artwork will accompany the acceptance notification. The Student Release form must be filled out and returned in order for the artwork to be exhibited.
