## **Description:**

This 9-day course will focus on curriculum development through the use of informative presentations and collaborative peer groups.

Presented information will include resources for curriculum mapping, lesson planning, educational philosophies and implementation strategies. Through the sharing of resources and information, participants will be able to either revise their existing lessons or develop a new curriculum all together.

Peer groups will provide participants with the chance to obtain relevant feedback and constructive criticism as well as the space to share ideas and lessons to make the process of curating an art curriculum easier and more effective.

# **Objectives of this course**

Participants will be able to:

- Consider varied approaches to curriculum and learning.
- Collaborate within a supportive peer group.
- Revise or develop curriculum to be used in their respective art programs

## This course will meet its purpose by:

- Providing resources and information about various curriculum planning strategies and philosophies.
- Creating a community of arts educators that encourages collaboration.
- Instilling confidence and capability around the planning of curriculum through discourse, practical applications and peer revision opportunities.

#### **Professional Development Points:**

Participants will earn 25 PDPs after active participation in full group sessions and evidence-based collaboration in peer group sessions and presentations.
